In April, we had a great time learning all about Spring and learning all about circle stories as we read the "If You Give..." series by Laura Numeroff. The children made some beautiful artwork this month that gave them the chance to be creative and practice their fine motor skills. We have also been working on recognizing beginning, middle and end sounds in words as well as how many syllables a word has in order to create a strong foundation towards reading.

Another highlight of the month was our outdoor adventure with the SOGO program. The children enjoyed searching for the flags on the map and were very active participants. I

was very proud of how much energy and effort they put into this program.
